HOW CAN I BE COUNTED?

You can be counted by completing the simple 9 question form at: my2020census.gov or by phone at 1-844-330-2020

The Census WILL NOT ask:

- \times What is your citizenship status?
- × What is your income?
- × Can you provide a credit card or account number?
- × What is your social security number?

The Census WILL ask:

- ✓ How many people are living or staying at your home?
- ✓ What are their sex, age, race, and ethnicity?
- ✓ Is your home owned or rented?
- ✓ What is your home address?

WHO should be counted?

- **✓**COUNT EVERYONE!
- Everyone staying in the house counts grandchildren, roommates, friends and family.
