Bidding to Win + Construction Management at Risk + DBE Certification

Wednesday, June 22nd | 10:00am - 12:00pm



Join the Urban League of Louisiana on Wednesday, June 22nd, 10:00am-12:00pm, for "Bidding to Win + Construction Management at Risk".

Construction firms understand that hard work has to happen before a single shovel ever hits the ground during the continuous constructionbid-proposal process. Submitting effective

proposals and winning bids is at the heart of what contractors do and developing this as a core competency is critical to building a profitable and sustainable business.

For general contractors, a bid-to-win rate of 1 out of 6 is standard, and many see less of a conversion rate. During this session, contractors will learn best practices for developing a competitive proposal, including: positioning the firm to move quickly on submitting bid proposals, creating a winning scope sheet, developing and offering a value proposition, and

putting your plans into action.

In addition, participants, will gain an understanding of the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) delivery method which entails a commitment by the Construction Manager (CM) to deliver the project within a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) which is based on the construction documents and specifications at the time of the GMP. This session will also include an overview of the LAUCP DBE Certification including eligibility requirements and the application process.

All aspiring DBEs are welcomed to attend. There is no cost to attend; however, registration is required. **Register today to reserve your seat!**

Management Center, 10 Veterans Memorial Blvd New Orleans, LA 70124, 1st Floor Conference Room.

Federal regulations 49, Part 26.45(g)(1) states, "In establishing an overall goal, you must provide for public participation. This public participation must include consultation with minority, women and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and your efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs."

The Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LADOTD) is committed to delivering transportation and public works systems that enhance the quality of life. LED's Bond guarantees may mitigate some risk to surety company, leading to a
