Energy Smart (Orleans Parish) and Entergy Solutions (All Other Parishes in LA) are comprehensive energy efficiency programs that incentivize Entergy customers to perform energy saving upgrades in their homes and businesses. What is a trade ally?

Trade allies can leverage these cash incentives to gain new customers and maximize existing customer projects that reduce energy use.

Trade allies are invited to participate in various training, development and networking opportunities provided by the program and its partners.
